### BOISE CASCADE PACKAGING BUSINESS EARNS SFI CERTIFICATION Exceeds required standards

BOISE, Idaho – All six corrugated manufacturing plants and the packaging business headquarters operated by Boise Cascade, LLC, have earned Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®) certification.

"Achieving SFI certification on our packaging provides our customers with assurance that Boise continues to be actively concerned about the environment and the future," said Judy Lassa, vice president, Boise Packaging.

Boise's packaging products are authorized to use the SFI Certified Sourcing product label. To earn use of the label, two-thirds of a company's packaging raw material must originate from mills with certified wood procurement systems or recycled paper sources. Boise exceeds this requirement with 71 percent of our corrugated plants' raw materials coming from sources certified by the SFI standard.

The SFI program is a comprehensive system of principles, objectives, and performance measures developed by professional foresters, conservationists, scientists, and others. The program combines the perpetual growing and harvesting of trees with the long-term protection of forest biodiversity, wildlife, plants, soil, and water quality.
